Age Relaxation

The upper age limit may be relaxed up to a maximum of five years in exceptional cases by the Admission Officer of the concerned programme if he/she is satisfied with the merit of the case. Candidates exceeding the upper age limit up to five years may provisionally apply/ appear in the Common Entrance Test. However, they would be required to submit to the satisfaction of the Admission Officer an explanation regarding the gap period, i.e., the details of the period spent by him/her after passing the qualifying examination to justify the relaxation. Such explanation should be in the form of an application to the concerned Admission Officer along with supporting documents (if any).

Relaxation in the Requirement of Marks for Reserved Category Candidates. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Widows or Wards of Defense Personnel / Physically Handicapped/ Kashmiri Migrant will be allowed 5% relaxation of marks in the minimum eligibility requirement, irrespective of the fact whether there exists any reservation for any category of such candidates or not.
